The previous evening the Leadership met with the Cowboy preacher to plan the order of the service that included Steve sharing a quarterly update about Hilltop Christian Fellowship and message regarding the 5th commandment and honoring mothers and fathers, and the pursuing promises of God. The Leadership thought all was agreeable. We are sorry that service did not happen as expected. The leadership at Hilltop Christian fellowship apologize for any hurt resulting from yesterday's events.

We would like to make a statement that in no way did we turn you away Sunday or foresee that the congregation would be turned away by the parking lot event that took place.

Steve and his family arrived at the barn approximately 10am ready to greet the pastor and attendees, but then discovered that items were packed up, decorations, music stands, etc. There were several individuals there moving items. Also we noticed a Sherriff car on the property, driven by the pastor's wife. **Please let it be known we did not tell these individuals to move these items or that there would not be service on Sunday. Nor did we turn any of you away and tell any of you to leave.**

For those 12 people that did break the lines of contention and stayed we trust that you were blessed.

Please know Cowboy church is experiencing a growing pain, and out of growing pains comes maturity. Our desire is a new Cowboy preacher, mature in the word and mature in the Christian Spiritual walk and leadership. As we all mature through this experience we will see blessings.

Cowboy church attendees are welcome to the Church on the hill for the weeks to come. The summer days are going to get hot and we have air conditioning in the garage of the house on the hill where we hold service. And the indoor comforts of the house for fellowship afterward.

Hilltop Christian Fellowship, Inc. has been in existence since mid-2021, starting with service at the house, and expanded with a Cowboy Service when a relationship formed with Pastor Eric in February of this year, 2023 with Steve and Eric both sharing a vision for revival. Eric was invited onto our property to offer a unique kind of service to the community at our barn property of the 110 acre estate.

I explained to Pastor Eric the night before (Saturday evening May 13th, 2023) in the presence of my wife and Pastor Pamela Andrews, that I wished to share the history of Hilltop Christian Fellowship and explain any confusion there might be over recent information received, and any word around town over a corporation registered April 19 as "Grit-N-Grace Cowboy Church", unbeknownst to Hilltop Christian Fellowship.
